### Angels on the Move

#### I. My Journey into the Realm of Angels

- A. I had Wisdom and Counsel angels in my counseling room.
- B. Positioning ourselves:
  - 1. Intimacy is the key for access into the heavenly realm.
  - 2. Learning to hear His voice.
  - 3. Ask and you shall receive. (Ephesians 1:17-21)
- C. Angelic movement isn't random. It's strategic, timely, and purposeful, orchestrated to fulfill God's will.
  - 1. Scripture is filled with angels on assignment to help establish the Kingdom of God. Angels appear 428 times: 252 times in the Old Testament, 177 times in the New Testament (in Revelation). Angels are also mentioned 51 times in the Gospels.
  - 2. Angels are the divine army, deployed to guide us in numerous ways. They are one of God's avenues in assisting His people.
  - 3. Angels assist Holy Spirit. (Hebrews 1:14)
  - 4. Angels work to enforce God's Word. (Psalm 103:30)
  - 5. Angels are deployed on our behalf for the purposes God intends, for the ultimate good of the Kingdom of God.
- D. Jesus is superior to angels.

## **II. How to Know if Angels Are Present**

### **A. There are unlimited ways for angels to make themselves known:**

1. Angels can materialize physically or appear in visions or in dreams.
2. Angels sing and worship. (Acts 12:6–12)
3. Angels speak. (Matthew 28:5)
4. Angels can receive refreshment. (Genesis 18:2–8)
5. Angels rejoice. (Luke 15:10)
6. Angels are called to serve. (Hebrews 1:7,14)
7. Angels perform assigned tasks. (Hebrews 1:14)
8. Angels listen, encircle us, empower us, and show us how to escape. (Psalm 34:7)
9. Angels can manifest as people.
10. Angels present as light.

### **B. Discerning the presence of angels**

1. The gift of discerning spirits is extremely important and must be cultivated so that we are not corrupted by false angels.
2. Solomon sought for an understanding heart so that he could discern between good and evil. (1 Kings 3:9)
3. Discernment is crucial as we journey through life, guiding us in both spiritual matters and everyday choices.
4. Satan disguises himself as an angel of light. (2 Corinthians 11:14)
5. An angel, which is a spirit, should not be believed just because it's a spirit. (1 John 4:1) We must test the spirits to see whether they are from God or not.
6. An angel could be a deceitful spirit. (1 Timothy 4:1)
7. An angel is to be accursed if he proclaims another gospel. (Galatians 1:8)

## **III. Intentions of Angels**

### **A. The plan of fallen angels:**

1. To cause confusion around the spiritual realm. They speak only a flavor of God that initially catches our attention.
2. To challenge our theology and belief system.
3. To take our lives captive for the purpose of evil.
4. To torment and harm you.

**B. Intentions of holy angels:**

1. Authentic angels receive their commands from the Lord. (Psalm 103:19–21)
2. Authentic angels always shift a person's focus to God.
3. Authentic angels never contradict scripture, anything Jesus said or did, and always encourage us to grow toward the likeness of Christ.
4. Holy angels never remain in the center of a person's interest or focus. They come with a message to help us in the specific assignment God has given them.
5. Holy angels assist us in making wise decisions.
6. Angels protect, provide, empower, guide, redirect, warn, rescue, and fight for us.
